With respect to the Passport it do not require renewal because it is a Diplomatic Passport.—
The Diplomatic Passport has a validity as long as the bearer has his charge, and do not expire at any date or period unless the bearer loss his diplomatic status.—

As you can see in the Inmigration form attached to the Passport the U.S. authorities have granted to Gabriela "Duration of Status" in the space named "Date to which admitted".— They have granted, too, a Diplomatic Visa A-l for unlimited applications.— So you have nothing to worry about the Passport.—
