good idea for him to join the Instituto  
and take advantage of the opportunities  
for conversation and association with  
Americans which membership would  
afford.

I hope that he will come in  
to see me soon. I shall do everything  
I can to be of help to him.  
If I can get away from the  
office, I plan to visit Petropolis within  
a few weeks. I shall look forward to  
seeing you there.  
I am sending you a copy of
