My dear Miss Mistral:

We were delighted to learn of your visit here in connection with your membership on the Subcommittee of the Status of Women of the Security Council.

The Council for Inter-American Cooperation, largely an outgrowth of the now terminated domestic program of the Office of Inter-American Affairs, is carrying on an extensive program to promote closer cultural, commercial and social ties in this hemisphere. Through a chain of Inter-American Centers in the large cities in the United States, the Council, among other activities, distributes printed materials, makes available a library of over 700 films on Latin America, tours prominent speakers, and extends hospitality to visiting Latin Americans. A weekly digest of hemisphere news called "Noticias" is published and widely circulated to leaders in inter-American affairs, educators, government officials, and business men. Miss Karna Steelquist, who is in charge of the publication of "Noticias", and I would like very much to interview you on Friday, May 3, at your convenience for inclusion of a write-up of your visit here in next week's issue. We would very much like to have your picture on the front page.
