Dear Sir:

I have the honor to submit to you the petition of Lucila Godoy (Gabriela Mistral) to evict three tenants from the house at 1305 Buena Vista, Duarte, California.

The official papers for the requests for eviction have been submitted to you by Idella Purnell Stone who held Miss Godoy's power of attorney to transact this operation for her with you while Miss Godoy (Gabriela Mistral) was absent at the U. N. Conference to which she has been a delegate. They were mailed, registered, from Sierra Madre on June 6, 1946.

Lucila Godoy (Gabriela Mistral), Chilean Consul for Southern California, being unable to find a house for rent suitable to her health needs, has bought a one-family house in Duarte; the lower story of the house being occupied by relatives of the seller and the upper half rented to two families. It was agreed at the time of sale, that the proprietor's relatives would vacate their portion of the house within a month, a condition which has not been fulfilled.

The condition of health of Consul Lucila Godoy (Gabriela Mistral) requires that she occupy as soon as possible at least half the house, and this Consulate General respectfully petitions that the O.P.A. consider this circumstance.

On June 2 the furniture and books of Lucila Godoy (Gabriela
