My dear Miss Mistral:

The Department refers to its letter of March 15, 1946 and again extends to you a very cordial invitation to be its guest for the purpose of visiting cultural and educational centers in the United States. This grant would provide a per diem of ten dollars (\$10) for a period not to exceed three months and necessary travel in this country.

At the time of your last visit in Washington, the subject of holding an Assembly of Librarians as a cooperative project between the Department and the Library of Congress, was discussed with you. Plans for this Assembly have now been completed, and under the direction of Mr. Luther H. Evans, and through the assistance of the Department, approximately thirty leading Latin American Librarians have been invited to attend. This conference will give these librarians their first opportunity to meet together for the discussion of their common library and bibliographical problems and to become acquainted personally with other library leaders in the Western Hemisphere. They will discuss the exchange of personnel and materials, consult concerning problems pertaining to Latin America as they are encountered in North American Libraries, and consider international cataloging codes and bibliographical measures in general.

The Assembly will open on May 12, 1947, and will continue for a period of eight weeks, with four weeks in Washington to be followed by a three weeks tour of United States Libraries and the attendance of the delegates at the annual conference of the American Library Association in San Francisco, California, from June 29 through July 5.
