My dear Miss Mistral:

The receipt is acknowledged of your letter of February 22, 1947 concerning your attendance at the forthcoming Assembly of Librarians to be held in Washington, D.C. in May and June, 1947. I was sorry to learn of your recent illness and it is hoped that you are now well on the road to recovery.

We are very happy to learn that you will be able to address the Assembly of Librarians in Washington on May 17, 1947, and that you plan to attend the meeting of the Assembly for one week. Your trip to Smith College and other universities and colleges in New England will be planned for you in accordance with your stated wishes. In view of the existing regulations regarding the travel grant program of the Department, it is regretted that the Department can not make a division of your grant as indicated in your letter. Therefore, a grant is being prepared for three months, subject to change upon consultation with you during your stay here. It is suggested that further changes in your proposed itinerary may be discussed upon your arrival in Washington. The Department, of course, would not want you to take any risk which would retard your recovery.

Transportation requests for your trip to Washington, D.C. will be forwarded to you shortly. The Department will make hotel reservations for you in Washington upon receipt of notification of the date of your arrival.
