About 3 weeks ago our Chaplain at Nazareth saw a brief notice of this new award. He told me and said I should ask my superior for permission to come. The Superior said No. Then she asked me: "Sister, how did you happen to choose Gabriela for your thesis topic?" So I told her the story and how admirable you were. I could see she was getting more enthused all the time, but the answer was still No. I decided it was the will of God and proceeded to forget it. Then, last Sunday Reverend Mother sent for me and said: "Sister, you may go to Washington." It is a very great permission. I feel so privileged. You will see me, won't you? I shall be happy to meet you when and where you specify. I know you are a very busy woman and only the great
