I would like your permission to translate one or two of your poems for an article I am writing about you.

I am a student, a senior, at Dickinson College. You probably have never heard of Dickinson College, it is a small college and not very famous. Our claim to fame is based on the age of the college (-it was founded in 1773-) and two very important graduates: Roger Brooke Taney, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, and James Buchanan, a United States' president. It is an old college, with many traditions and thick ivy walls, but not very well known outside Cumberland Valley.
