about your recent loss. Since my plans did not materialize,
I am sending this little note to let you know that I've been
thinking about you and understand so well how difficult it
is to make adjustments after one has lost a dear one.

Regarding Luis Escragualle, I fear that there is little hope of being able to arrange a scholarship for him since he has not received his degree first from Brasil. The tendency is to send graduate students now and even those have a difficult time to get up to the States even after having been offered a fellowship. I would suggest that he study his english and continue his studies of architecture
