Dearest Gabriela:

I can't tell you how pleased and happy I was to learn of the Nobel prize award. It gives all of us who know and love you a great sense that splendid justice has been done. This letter will probably follow you to Sweden, where I can imagine you and Connie wrapt in furs, trying to bear that dreadful climate.

The press tells me that you were about ready to start for California when you got the news of the Nobel prize, and changed your itinerary. If you should be coming to the United States on your return from Europe, I certainly hope that I shall have the pleasure of seeing you in Albuquerque. It is almost necessary to pass through here on your way to California. Unfortunately, my mother is ill, and I cannot urge you to be a guest in our house; but if you can spend a few days here in a hotel, it would be my great pleasure to show you something of the New Mexico I love to tell you about.
