My dear Mr. Ambassador:

This letter brings you a cordial invitation to have someone from your country attend our Fifth Annual June Conference in Hartford, Connecticut, June 21st to 24th. Our general theme will be "The World's Children". Our first conference was planned at the request of the Women's Bureau, Department of Labor, to offer an opportunity to foreign women visiting in this country to meet the leaders of women's organizations and discuss their common problems together. It has now become a conference of great interest to our women leaders in Connecticut and from neighboring states, and last year's attendance numbered some three hundred people. Each year we have had a considerable number of foreign visitors, usually from Europe, Asia, and Africa.

We have not had the opportunity of knowing many of the nationals from your country, although our experience during the last few years has demonstrated that personal acquaintance is one of the best ways to develop international understanding. Our women here in Connecticut are disturbed by their lack of knowledge of the social customs and opinions of people from other parts of this hemisphere and would welcome a chance to know you and your country's women much better.

I am enclosing a small brochure about the Bureau and some current calendars.

Mr.Philip Mettger of the Governmental Affairs Institute, 1785 Mass.Ave., N.W., Washington, D. ., has worked with us on planning trips for many foreign visitors and is familiar with our work. He has told me he would be very glad to inform you about it. A former member of our Advisory Board and former Congresswoman from Connecticut (Mrs.Chase Going Woodhouse) would welcome an opportunity to tell you about our over-all work and the plans for this Conference.
