I am sending you with this the translations of the forty-six poems on which I was working last spring. Your agents in New York, Ann Watkins, Inc., also have a complete copy of them. I went to see them two or three weeks ago, and they told me that they were waiting for a letter from you to give them the authority to show the poems to publishers. They also told me you wanted someone to translate your prose writings. I have translated prose as well as poetry and will be very glad to undertake the translation of the prose you wish to include in your anthology.

I will be willing to take the long journey across the continent to discuss the poems with you, if you can give me the assurance that you like my work well enough to make me your translator for the anthology which you said New York publishers were anxious to bring out. I am a great admirer of your poetry, and should feel much honored if you will authorize me to go on with this work which I have
