Dear Gabriela:

This acknowledges with a great deal of thanks your letter of November 1 telling me that a commercial company has asked the rights to reproduce the poetry which you recorded in the Library of Congress during December 1950. I appreciate very much your offer to have a copy of these reproductions sent to the Library of Congress when they appear.

I am informed that at present our policy in regard to original recordings of our English-speaking poetry recordings is to make a copy of the poetry at the cost of the person requesting it, upon receiving written instructions of the poet. What the requester does with the recording is between him and the copyright holder, who is the poet. I see no reason that the same doctrine cannot apply to the Hispanic poetry recordings, although up to this time no concrete case has arisen before this one.
