Believing that certain spiritual values are the common heritage of all mankind, my newspaper has asked me to obtain from each of the leading women at the United Nations a statement as to how, in her eyes, the work of the UN is related to her own religious concepts.

I will appreciate it very much if you can spare a few moments to give me two or three paragraphs on this subject for which I can assure widespread circulation. You may want to use the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as a guide, though any approach to the subject will be satisfactory.
