My dear Miss Clark:

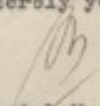

Miss Mistral as well as the Government of Chile feel honored by the distinction to be granted to her by Smith College. This constitutes not only another guerdon for our poet, but also a new spiritual bond between the United States and Chile. For this reason, both Miss Mistral and the Government, regrets exceedingly that it is necessary to request this postponement of the ceremony.
