I have made an Application to obtain a Visa but without success. My records in the past as well as in the present are excellent, besides I would be able to transfer about £ 500 which I have been saving up.-

So dear Senorita, would you please be good enough in granting me a Visa to immigrate to Chile in the near future, I should be most grateful indeed.-

Please do favour me with your answer and make me to the happiest person on earth.-
