Again at home I have received your kind letter of February 26. I thank you very much for having taken care of the letter enclosed in yours, from a niece of mine in Zululand of South Africa that had been forwarded - a game of chance - to Miss Mistral. The fortune didn't give me, in spite of mutual good intentions, an opportunity to meet again Miss Mistral when, on my pilgrimage in America, I was in Los Angeles. Will it be given at another time in another place? I had come to Los Angeles from South America and I went from there to Yosemite National Park to get a sight and a feeling of the Sequoia trees, this wonder of the creation fascinating mind and imagination. I was also at Grand Canyon, Wis. and at the Boulder Dam. And after a staying in Pittsburgh and New York, I returned to Sweden for perhaps - *vita contemplativa senectutis* -
