Dear Miss Mistral:

I am uneasy at the seeming lack of progress in placing your poetry and possibly your prose before the English-reading public. Since Mrs. Biddle's departure we have had the gratuitous translations of Miss Turnbull, which I now note have not found acceptance. I would like to explore the limited sources of translators who are competent to do justice to your work. It is my opinion that the primary requisite is that the translator be a poet in his own right and secondarily knowledgeable in Spanish.

I have talked to Harry Maule of Random House and he has one such person in mind. Others ~~with~~ whom I have had conversations during the last year have made recommendations too. I would not want to investigate more fully without your approval.

I shall be glad to hear from you.
