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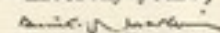
Dear Miss Mistral:

I have had an exchange of correspondence with Nicholson Adams of the University of North Carolina about the possibility of his translating a selected number of your works. Unfortunately, he, like so many teachers, has his hands full with present commitments and, while he is an admirer of your work, he is not in a position at the present time to think about taking an additional burden.

The exchange of letters has, however, set me to thinking again about your problem. I have not asked you in the last couple of years if you had any candidates in mind. I would appreciate your writing me if you do think of two or three likely poets.

If a suitable person is found, I think it would be fair to propose a division of royalties on a basis of 2/5 to the translator and the balance to you, with copyright held in the name of the publisher. I would hope that you would select the prose and the poetry to be translated.
