Dear Mr. Nagels,

On June 12th we sent you five photographs of Gabriela Mistral to be included in your edition of her poems. We have only now been able to get the captions and also the necessary information as to whether or not any of these photographs have to be cleared.

You will have noticed that the prints are numbered, and the captions listed here follow in that order:

1. Gabriela Mistral with Hon. Dag Hammarskjold at the United Nations on Human Rights Day, December 1955. On this occasion she was invited by Mr. Hammarskjold to be the guest speaker.
2. Gabriela Mistral (then known as Lucila Godoy Alosyaga) at her first communion at the age of seven.
3. Gabriela Mistral in 1917 as a rural school teacher in the village of Los Andes, Chile.
4. Gabriela Mistral in her home in Santa Barbara, California, in 1948. She served as Consul of Chile in California for several years.
5. Gabriela Mistral in Italy, 1951. She served as Consul of Chile in Rapallo and later in Naples.

Pictures 2, 3, and 5, belong to Miss Doris Dana. They are free and no fees are involved. Picture 1 must be cleared by you through Leo Rosenthal, 315 West 102 Street, New York 25, N. Y. As for picture 4, no clearance is necessary but a credit line must be given: Photograph by George F. Wald, Santa Barbara, California.

In regard to the photographs sent you on May 12th, Miss Dana writes us: "The photocopy of the manuscript poems "Noche de San Juan" was written for the last book Gabriela Mistral published in her lifetime, LADAR. This particular poem was written in 1943.

"The other close-up picture of Gabriela Mistral was taken in 1954 in Roslyn, Long Island, New York."
