Dear Miss Bates,

Thank you for your note of April 3 which I was able to discuss with Doris before she took off on a lecture trip out west.

The most important thing for you to remember is please not to send any material to Aguilar before I have in hand the signed new contract with them covering the publication of this new edition which I am presently negotiating with them.

Doris said that she had discussed this previously with you; and since you told me earlier that you would send the manuscript to me before giving it to Aguilar, I feel reassured that you have not as yet put me in an unfavorable bargaining position by sending it to them.

Otherwise, I can tell you that there has been no change in plans; Aguilar will publish the third edition of the *POESIAS COMPLETAS* with only the addition of the new preface and new introduction and notes. The many other poems which Gabriella published in reviews or books and then later rejected will be collected and screened by Doris for use in a later volume.
