Now I understand Lisa Johns question: if stanza 4 on page 100 is translated "We were all to be queens/and we would truly reign" should not stanza 6 on page 102 be translated "On the earth we will be queens/ and we shall truly reign" - since in Spanish the construction is parallel? The answer depends, I think, on the demands of the English, how it will sound best, as well as on the Spanish construction.
