Thank you for your letter of 5 October regarding our volume of Gabriela Mistral's poems. Actually, we've had sample pages in the house for quite awhile now, but have been holding them pending the arrival of the first woodcut from Mr. Frasconi. He told Miss Sheer that we would have it around the first of October. Our concern, of course, is to achieve for the book a thoroughly integrated design in which the typography and illustrations complement each other.

Richard Shaw, our production manager, will telephone Mr. Frasconi to learn the status of that first woodcut. If it is nearly ready, I think we'll keep with our plan to see that before sending out the samples. If it is to be delayed, however, we'll send them off immediately. Either way, we'll certainly clear them through your office, as I promised Miss Daves we would.

Meanwhile, Miss Schutt has talked with Doris Dana to explain the seeming delay.
