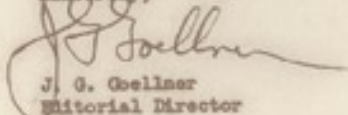
Dear Miss Katz:

Thank you for your letter of 5 October regarding our volume of Gabriela Mistral's poems.
