- 1) Copy of the Book Review written by Dudley Fitts in the New York Times, December, 1957, when Langston Hughes book of translations appeared. Thought you might like to read it -- I thought it was excellent. I also think I should write to him about the possibility of his reviewing my book.
- 2) 14 pages to be incorporated into the copy of the book I left with you. Please note that I have made one change in the CONTENTS. Pages 17 and 19 are now BALADA instead of TRIBULACION.
