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Chile's 1st Woman Envoy Leads U. S.

The arrival of the first woman
 consul general of Chile in the United States
 is expected to mark a new chapter in the
 history of Chilean-American relations.
 The new consul general, Mrs. Juanita
 de la Cruz, is expected to arrive in New York
 City on Tuesday, Feb. 12, and to be
 sworn in at the U.S. Consulate in New York
 City on Wednesday, Feb. 13.

Mrs. de la Cruz, who is 45 years old,
 was born in Chile and has lived in the United States
 for many years. She is a graduate of the
 University of Chile and has a degree in
 law. She has been married for 15 years
 and has two children. She is a member of
 the Chilean Women's Club in New York City
 and is active in the club's activities.

Mrs. de la Cruz will be the first woman
 consul general of Chile in the United States.
 She will be succeeded by Mr. Juanita de la Cruz
 in the fall of 1958.
