I had the honor of studying with Gabriela when she taught at Barnard College in New York so many years ago, and also knew her out here when she was living in Santa Barbara. I do hope that you will be able to help me with these permissions. I found out from Georgetown M. Dorn of the Library of Congress that you were Gabriela's executrix and literary heir.
