I still have to acknowledge your letter of April 29. I have passed on the information to Miss Doris Dana, the executrix of the Gabriella Mistral estate, and Miss Dana was very happy to hear that you are still definitely planning to eventually issue the full-length record of Gabriela reading her own poems. When and if you are ready to realize the project, please be in touch with me so that we can make more formal arrangements.

It may interest you that the Spanish publishers, Aguilar, are planning on issuing the Library of Congress recording of Gabriela's poetry readings. Thus far we have granted them the right to distribute this record in the Spanish speaking countries only -- could you foresee any conflict with your future plans if the Spanish recording were distributed in this country also?
