Dear Marianne:

Yes, indeed, we should move on the Weiss contracts. I have asked Leon Fellman to see which of his suggestions made in connection with the mimeographed agreements you sent in are essential so that we might get the necessary signatures and legalize the fait accompli. We shall be back at you within a few days.

As to the preliminary action on the Mistral recording: Doris told me about her talk with you and there is no reason why we can't get going on the agreements. As I understand it, the material on the Library of Congress recording does not need any editing but that the tapes which you have will need a good deal of it. The understanding is that Doris will do the necessary editing and write the copy for the jacket.

Which territory would you want for the distribution of the recording under the Caedmon label? What advance and royalties can you offer? I shall look forward to hearing from you.
