You did a marvelous job as detective and thank you for your efforts! Would you please be my personal "Ambassador" in Mexico with the Editorial Porrúa. I am extremely interested that Lecturas para Mujeres be published again and hope we can get this moving almost immediately.

Please explain to Senor Jose Porrúa that the reasons for my silence have been manifold. I have been away for quite some time, but the principle reason has been difficulties with the literary agency that represents me. These matters can be very delicate, as you can imagine, but it has come to the point where for Gabriela's interests I have had to break off a very long-standing relationship with this agency. The contract which Senor Porrúa sent me is not an adequate contract and I have had to wait to settle the agency problem in order to get the professional help I need regarding this type of contract.

Now at last this problem has been solved here and I will obtain this week a contract that includes all the points I consider most essential. If Senor Porrúa will accept the terms, I will be very happy to sign immediately.

Please give my most sincere apologies to Senor Porrúa for this long delay. And thank you, dear Concha, for your kind effort in this matter.

I hope to see you when I am next in Washington.
