Thank you for your very kind letter of January 2, 1963.

Regarding the permission to publish some selections from Desolacion, Tala and Legar, it is I who must give the permission. I suggest you write to my agent Miss Jean Daves, Rodell and Daves, 15 East 88th St., New York City, and she can send you the necessary forms.

You ask about the long poem about Chile. It was never really finished nor put together in its proper stanzas. I personally finished editing this and prepared it for publication a short time ago. I plan to publish this in *Boards*, the Editorial in Buenos Aires.

If it is not too much to ask, I would appreciate receiving a copy of your biographical study so that I might better determine in what way I might help you. As a general rule I have kept apart from my biography of Gabriela Mistral because I have found that sometimes even the most esteemed writers and critics have too often published erroneous data and misinterpretations of the facts of Gabriela's life. However, I would like to be of assistance to you providing I could first see the study that you have written.
