Regarding Mrs. Thompson, as I told you in my letter, she has been gravely ill. For a while she seemed to be better and was even taken home for a few days, but then she started to get fever and kept turning worse. Finally she was taken back to the Hospital; her blood pressure went down to 50, and the doctors could not understand how she was still alive. She was hemorrhaging for several days, and in spite of several blood transfusions that were given to her, she got terribly weak. Finally she stopped bleeding and now she seems to be improving little by little, although, as I tell you, she is very very weak. She is still at the Hospital and will probably be there till the middle or end of next week.

Marga came back from New York when she heard her mother was so sick again, and Frank is arriving to-morrow. They had all gone back to the States thinking that she was better.

I have cancelled my trip to Europe for the time being, as I just don't feel I could possibly enjoy it; I just cannot turn around, say good-bye to everybody and leave Mr. Thompson precisely when he needs me more. Believe me we have had quite a time.

I hope you have had a very successful trip, Doris. Hope I can see more of you next time you come down this way.
