I can be reached at the Hotel Mexico, Jalapa, Veracruz, Mex. until around the 23rd of March. On the 26th of March we are leaving for Italy. (The boat leaves from Veracruz.) Later I will let you know where I can be reached in Europe.

I hope my other letter did not go astray -- but am sending the copy on in case.
