Thank you for your letter of March 25th. I am glad to learn that Miss Dana is sending us the Nobel Prize Citation. I am writing Mr. Hughes today to check on the introduction which I believe he is going to write. As you may recall we approached Archibald MacLeish but found he was not available. I appreciate Miss Dana's desire to check the introductory material and I think it would be wonderful to have a book on Gabriela Mistral which would not contain the usual errors, omissions, mistranslations etc.. So let's have a definite understanding that Miss Dana will see the entire text preferably in manuscript form with this end in view.

With all the pitfalls between manuscript and published book I sometimes marvel that books get published at all.

It is kind of you to offer to handle the British rights in England but British rights to all our books are now being handled by Mark Paterson, 37 Panton Street, Haymarket, London.
