Does this total amount sent to Mademoiselle Pomes (6658 francs) refer only to the years 1962-67 as you mention in your letter of October 26, or does it include earlier years?

I have been away but am now permanently settled again at Hack Green Road, Pound Ridge, New York. On a recent visit to Thomas Merton (Father Louis Merton) at the Abbey of Gethsemani, Trappist, Kentucky, he discussed with me some of the literary problems he has been having with a certain Marie Tadie in France. I told him about you and your great kindness to me in respect to the Mistral difficulties. A letter I received today from Father Merton tells me that the Reverend Father Abbot has written to you about Merton's problem. I feel confident that you can be of help to them, and trust that it would not be an imposition.

Do you have any news from Gallimard or from Rombaldi about royalties? As you will remember I am particularly anxious to know about the Rombaldi edition which was totally unauthorized. I will be here in Pound Ridge now until further notice, so please keep in touch with me here.

I want to thank you both for all your great kindness and good help.
