Thank you for your promise of keeping us informed of the progress of your journey. Our telephone here is OLiver 6146.

I have made the following arrangements for hotel reservations. If they seem unsatisfactory in any detail, kindly let me know by telegram, and I shall be happy to arrange something perfectly according to your desires. You know, however, that often there are difficulties in the way of making reservations, and hence I would appreciate an early indication from you of your preferences. In case you want these reservations changed, it will be impossible to send you word of the new arrangements, and in that case you will have to call us before you approach the city. Do not hesitate to call at any hour of the day or night. The arrangements I have thus far made are for a single room with twin beds and a bath at the Hotel Gralyn, 1746 N St., N.W. This is not the most modern hotel, but it seems to meet your desire for a place outside the noise and confusion of the city. You likewise specified a room -- which I take to mean a single room. Of course, if you prefer separate rooms, it is merely a matter of informing me to that effect. The hotel is located on N St. between 17th and 18th, between Massachusetts and Rhode Island Avenues. I am enclosing a map with the approximate site marked; you will note that N St. is a one-way St.
