

Dear Dr. Mistral:

After careful consideration of all of the suggestions which have thus far been received from our list of distinguished Central and South American invitees, Dr. Lleras has proposed a definitive program for the use of this Conference. I am enclosing a copy of the outline of this program, both in English and Spanish. I am also enclosing a list of the persons who have thus far agreed to participate in the Conference. There will be a comparable list of persons selected from Canada and the United States.

In view of the desirability of having all the topics of the program dealt with at the Conference, it is suggested that you frame your address on "In Defense of Human Freedom in the Field of Knowledge" as an aspect of Topic 1, namely, Elementary, Primary and Secondary Education. The other persons requested to deal with this same general field are: Justo Pastor Benítez, Fernando Diez de Medina, and Gale Plaza. If for any reason this particular allocation of topic does not seem to you desirable, please let us know promptly so that we can keep a balance in the eventual program.
