
Dear Mrs. Mistral:

I am pleased to enclose herewith the text of the manifesto on the crime of genocide which I feel certain expresses your views upon the subject. There is no doubt in my mind that, because it bears your name and the names of other distinguished leaders of world public opinion, it will be instrumental in expediting action by the United Nations General Assembly.

At the present moment, the Convention on the Crime of Genocide is in the hands of Sub-Committee II of the Legal Committee of the Assembly. It is expected that the Sub-Committee will open discussion on the convention within the next few days for reference to the Legal Committee and subsequent submission to the General Assembly.

Please accept my warm thanks for the enthusiasm and cooperation which you have accorded me in my efforts.
