Esteemed Sir and Colleague:

I have received a letter from the editors of the magazine Sur which all through the war was sympathetic to France. Sra. Victoria Ocampo, the owner and editor of the magazine, asks me to conduct an inquiry as to how to facilitate the journey of Mr. Roger Cailloes from Mexico City to Los Angeles.

Mr. Cailloes is recently appointed cultural ambassador to all the Hispanic Americas, a personal friend of M. Videt. In Buenos Aires he edits the magazine "Lettres Francaises", and in Paris he is adviser to the Gallimard Press for all its books translated from Spanish into French. But above all he is a great essay writer, judged the foremost of his generation. He began and continued the "Nouvelle Revue Francaise" until he was called by the magazine Sur to Buenos Aires. Finally, he is author of six books, three of which are dedicated to French affairs. I have a great admiration and esteem for him and his works.

M. Cailloes will give a series of lectures in Mexico City, and will visit the ancient monuments of that country.
