Dear Doris:

The Spanish Dept. of the Catholic University has been trying for a year now to make special arrangements with the University Press to publish in Spain small (about 500 copies) editions of scholarly books written by the faculty. But the sights of the Press are usually focussed upon books of a wider appeal since the machinery of the Press is too tremendous and expensive to run for small editions with a limited, slow market--certainly not books written in Spanish. In view of this impasse, the Department has decided to deal directly with printers and distributors in Spain. We are presently making arrangements with the Garriga Press in Barcelona and the Librería Porter (distributor) also in Barcelona. The latter is very reliable; it has been one of the Spanish agents for the Library of Congress since the Hispanic Foundation was instituted in 1939. Under the only plan that seems feasible the author will pay the heirs, if any, the total cost of the rights to publish, in advance. (the distributor does not have the book-keeping facilities for this) and he will also pay the cost of printing.

I enclose a copy of the skeleton of one of the simple contracts. In the case of the variant edition of DESOLACION it will be necessary also to include a table of contents since your copyright will be only for the texts.

Generally speaking, does this arrangement seem feasible to you?
