However, the quotations were actual cost prices and Jack says that he cannot see how they can be shaved.

The hard cover edition will retail here for \$10.00, the paperback for \$2.45 -- it will be an extraordinarily handsome book so that these prices do not seem out of line for our market.

John Hopkins Press must order their paper by April 1st at the latest, which leaves me just one month to make arrangements with another publisher if you can't see your way clear to bring out the book. Please give some thought to the matter and cable me as soon as ever possible.
