Your comments regarding the MISTRAL project and the suggested terms of your offer make good sense to me. The only problem is the artwork; Antonio Frasconi is too well known and too well paid over here for us to suggest that he take a small flat fee for the use of his wood cuts in the British edition. Thus we will have to arrange for him to get a percentage of the royalties and with that in mind, I wonder if you could not add something to the suggested royalty scale for both the hardcover and the paperback editions.

I have reminded Jack Geallner that you are awaiting the production prices and I hope that these will come to you without delay. I won't expect any binding commitment on your part until you have this important information. Meanwhile, we will not commit ourselves elsewhere.
