Dear Miss Adler:

As you suggested on the phone the other day, I am herewith sending you:

- 1) my recently-published bilingual book of translations of Gabriela Mistral's poetry, The Johns Hopkins Press.
- 2) the recording of Gabriela reading her poetry, made by the Library of Congress in 1950. (Sent under separate cover)
- 3) reviews and articles about the book which have appeared so far, as well as other informational material.
- 4) a summary of poems by Gabriela which appear in my book of English translations and which also appear on tape and records, read by Gabriela herself in Spanish. My summary includes approximate reading time for the Spanish and the English together.

You will see from the summary that of this group of twelve poems, six were recorded by The Library of Congress, and six were recorded by Caedmon. The latter have not yet been released to the public. I have heard the recording, and it is excellent. I believe there would be no trouble in getting permission to use the Caedmon material. However, if we should encounter any difficulty, we could just stick to The Library of Congress recordings.

The Library of Congress recording is the only item I shall ask you to return to me at a later date since this is a very limited edition.

I have indicated in my summary a suggested program in numerical sequence, but of course you may wish to make a different combination or a different sequence of poems.

When you have had a chance to review the material, please let me hear from you. I shall be out of the country from December 8th until February 20th, but I will be available for a program either before or after those two dates. I look forward to hearing from you.
