Dear Doris:

Got your letter yesterday. Good to hear that everything is going well and that there have been no incidents that ended in the *Pensión Española*. The day that gm was supposed to come was a very grey-yellow day here and quite nippy; from now on we should have a better deal. I was quite a Trojan for a while but began to forget to eat; now I am returning to my Trojanhood. This afternoon, I hope, I shall get around to writing a long "musical" letter to gm; I have been "confectioning" one in my head for a long time and it's become involved, full of overtones and undertones. I have almost finished the reorganization of my apto.--as you know I have a mind that organizes, arranges, sub-classifies, sub-sub-classifies etc.--now that my memory has practically left me I have to recur to gross classification, since no classification works unless it's in your head.

Did you find your Caillois that was in the cotovía-closet? I have ordered another one from France; they were in print a few months ago. I shall order one for you if you wish. Don't look any more for mine! In the back of my mind I see myself riding on a trolley reading it **AFTER** N.Y. The reason I mentioned it to you is that I really think that anything gm has to do with comes under the influence of "tragos y daendes." It would not surprise gm, for example, to find the book in Afghanistan. The other day I found the top of the pencil that I was sure I had left with you in June.

Tell gm that I hope she understands what her **DEBER** is now (I presume she has paid homage to Gea as ordered by the letter of the **wandona**); she must think seriously of making the **MUJERES LOCAS** of the UN más locas.

In the letter of Pound which you just forwarded to me there are **100 YR** (new year) wishes for you, gm, and the Paiges.
