had come into contact with the Indian Poet Rabindranath Tagore. The
meeting must have taken place either at New York or at the
San Isidro home of Madame Victoria Ocampo of Buenos Aires.

what kind of contact they had had, whether they were ever
photographed together or exchanged correspondence. Any documents
