Dear Sir or Madam:

The passing of the Who's Who in America biographee, a copy of whose last published "Who's Who" sketch is enclosed, was entered at the time of death in the records our editors keep both for the biennially published "Who's Who" necrologies and in preparation for the compilation of the next edition of WHO WAS WHO IN AMERICA which is now published on a decennial basis.

The time has now come to put this next edition of WHO WAS WHO - Volume III - into active compilation. It will cover the years 1951-1959 and will include the last published sketches of all Who's Who biographees who have passed on during that period.

Our purpose in sending you the enclosed last published Who's Who listing of the biographee named therein is two-fold: (1) as a double check on our necrology records; (2) to request your cooperation to the extent of checking the accuracy and completeness of the enclosed sketch - making revisions and additions on the special form to which it is attached, if in order - and as well to enter on that form the correct date of death and place of interment, as it is our practice to include this information in all sketches published in WHO WAS WHO when made available to our editors.

I should add that the editors fully realize you may have already provided such data when you were contacted, shortly after the biographee's death, in connection with the interim publication of the sketch in the WHO WAS WHO Section of the quarterly Supplement to Who's Who, a special service of ours to reference centers. But I trust you will appreciate that the editors' desire for absolute accuracy in listings to become biographical records for all time in WHO WAS WHO requires them to request this double check of the accuracy and completeness of the sketch itself, and, as well, that the date of death and place of interment be again supplied.

Please also sign the form and give your address so proofs of the revised listing may be sent for a final checking before printing.
