Dear Dr. Vogl:

For some time I've wanted to write to you to thank you with all my heart for your kind care of Gabriela during all these years and especially during her illness. She loved you very much and had implicit faith in you. She said near the end, "I know the doctors have done all they can for me."

Perhaps you will understand why I have been unable to write or to come to see you, as I wanted to. But my heart has been so very grateful to you, Dr. Vogl.

You should know that the Chilean government has, at long last, acknowledged its responsibility toward payment of your bill. Presumably, their lawyer here has submitted it to the Ministry of Foreign Relations in Chile.

Please know that I would have been more than happy to pay it myself, but my lawyer advised me that as executrix of Gabriela's estate I could not do this without being liable to suit by her heirs. The Chilean government knows this, and I have done my best to prod them. I most deeply regret the irresponsibility of the Chilean government and the delay they have caused.
