Dear Miss Montecino:

Thank you for your nice letter of July 12th, but there was no need for an apology. I understand from your letter that the Chilean Embassy does not receive ORFEO. If you do not already receive it, then please accept a subscription from me for display and use at the Embassy. For this reason I am returning to you the copy you so kindly sent on to me with your apology. And in the future when copies come in to the Embassy to be forwarded to me, please keep a copy for the Embassy's use.

If you think the Embassy would be interested in receiving more than one copy each time, please let me know, and as "Relacionadora Internacional" I will be happy to inform the Editors of Orfeo. I believe it is one of the very best, perhaps the best, Literary Magazine put out in Chile today.

The Embassy will be interested in knowing that at the moment I am located in Windham, New York -- a lovely mountain summer resort, and in the winter, one of the best ski resorts in the entire New York area -- where I have opened a very unusual business called CHILENOS UNIQUE. I am importing and selling, under this business name, the most beautiful woolen products that Chile has to offer -- coats, dresses, suits, ponchos, ruanas and children's clothing. The quality of the fabrics, and the textures, patterns and colors and styling are extremely beautiful.
