Dear Bill:

You must have wondered what happened to me and to the document. I had been having a few difficulties at this end of the line. There is a gentleman here from Chile for whom I negotiated a Rockefeller grant for the editing of Gabriela's poetry. In general, it has worked out, but I have had enough evidence of irresponsibility on his part to feel that I should not go to California until he was nearing the end of his work and the manuscripts were back in my safe keeping.

Enough said about this. The work is almost completed and I now feel free to go to California at any time you specify. Last week I gave up my job so that I could do more work on Gabriela's affairs, which I now feel able to do.

The document is signed but, fool that I am, I didn't read your letter carefully and inadvertently wrote her age in instead of leaving it to be typed by you. (Page 2) of the Petition for Probate). I hope this will not matter, but if it does let me know what I can do.

You can go ahead, then, and file this petition. When I come to California I will have a little time to see about the Santa Barbara situation. Neither Redditt (the lawyer) nor I have found any paper indicating the rate of interest on the mortgage for the property in Monrovia. Balance due as of the 1st of February is \$7,792.32. The interest seems to be 6%. A friend just helped me work it out. (It seems to fluctuate slightly from month to month. In October the balance due was \$7,973.66 and the interest at 6% should be \$39.85. They record \$39.87 in their statement of November 15. Unclear as this is, it still seems to be 6%).
