Alas, my home-coming has been marred by the fact that I have to go to the hospital for, not one operation, but two. I went to see Dr. Castrovicje about my wretched eye, and he says the tear-duct is so badly obstructed that only an operation will clear it up. But before the one on the eye I must have one on my nose, for a deviated septum, which is pressing on the eye duct. Neither of them are serious, nor, I gather, too painful, but they are a nuisance. When I think of what you went through, they are as nothing, but human nature being what it is, I grumble. I shall be going in for the first one next week.

I should have liked to write to Miss Halle, Rosita, and so many others who were so kind to us, but I must tie up so many loose ends before I leave. Will you please remember us affectionately to all of them, and tell them that we look forward to seeing them again.
